#### Annual Potluck Kick-Off

For more than 30 years, the Memphis IOWA Club has held a potluck meal on the Saturday before the first football game. Old friends gather, new friends are made, and memories cherished. This year's annual potluck is at 5:30 p.m. on August 24 at the Clubhouse at Schilling Farms, 290 Oak Club Lane in Collierville.

To get to the Clubhouse, turn south off of Winchester on Oak Club Lane. You'll soon see a white picket fence on the left that is by the Clubhouse. Guest parking is available on two sides of the Clubhouse or on the opposite side drive, but please don't block any residents' access to the garage or street. The scholarship started at \$250, but continues to increase every year. This year—coupled with the UIAA's match
